
## Life Sized Posable Sitting Skeleton



Once you have the skeleton assembled you can take each piece apart and use pvc glue to more securely attach each piece and pose the pieces so the prop is sitting in the position you desire (straight up in a chair - reclined and leaning on something). If you do not glue the neck, feet and the spine pieces you can take it apart after use and store it more easily. (however, if you don't glue it at all the pipes will slip and slide and come apart.) Not gluing the feet also allows you to dress the skeleton easier and put his/her shoes on.

We used 3/4" PVC pipe and elbows for our skeleton and dressed him in jeans, western shirt, boots and cowboy hat - reclined him on our porch bench seat like that's where he died.

Optional: you can drill a large hole in the bottom of gallon milk jug and slide it up to the top of the spine to give the illusion of ribs.
